(Information pursuant to Article 13, GDPR)

We're glad that you're interested in our company and that you have contacted us. The following information informs about how we process your personal data when you contact us in compliance with Article 13 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The **Controller** in the sense of data protection legislation is

Which of your data do we process – and for what purposes?

We process the data that you communicate to us when you contact us (e-mail, business card, enquiry, telephone call). It is processed for the purposes of initiating a business transaction, providing you with information or generally communicating with you.

It is also possible that your data will be stored and processed for purposes required by law.

Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data in this connection is primarily Article 6 (1) b) and f) (legitimate interests, e.g. to initiate a business transaction or provide requested information).

Duration of storage

Data which is collected when you contact us is stored for as long as is necessary to communicate with you, provide information to you, maintain a business relationship with you, and when we are legally required to store it. It will be deleted when

- the data is no longer required for the aforementioned purposes and it is unlikely that it will have to be processed again for those purposes;
- you exercise your right to request the erasure of the data;
- we are legally required to delete the data.

Data transfer

We only transfer the personal data concerning you that we collect to third parties if

- we are legally required to do so;
- it is necessary to perform contractual obligations;
- the third party has a legitimate interest to receive the data;
- you have consented to the transfer.

Under the above circumstances, personal data may be transferred to the following recipients:

processors engaged by us;
authorities;
public organizations;
customers and partners within and outside the Dürr Group.

Data transfers to countries outside the European Economic Area only take place if a Commission decision confirms the adequacy of the level of data protection in that country, if suitable data protection guarantees exist, if the transfer is necessary to fulfil employment contract obligations or if you have consented to the transfer.

Where are the data processed?

Personal data are processed in our internal systems, at the premises of processors with whom we have concluded contracts and at data centers in the Federal Republic of Germany.

Your rights as a data subject

- You have the **right to request information** from us about the personal data concerning you we process (Article 15 GDPR). If your request is not made in writing we may ask you to provide proof that you are the person you claim to be.
- You have the right to **rectification, erasure or restriction** of processing if you are legally entitled to do so (Article 16, 17, 18 GDPR).
- You have the right to **object to the processing of your personal data** if you are legally entitled to do so (Article 21 GDPR).
- You have the right to **data portability** if you are legally entitled to it (Article 20 GDPR).
- You have the **right to lodge a complaint**. This gives you the opportunity to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (State Data Protection Commissioner) if you believe that we are not processing your data correctly (Article 77 GDPR).
- When personal data is collected because you have provided your **consent**, you have the right to withdraw that consent without stating reasons (Article 7 (3) DSGVO).
